Amy read the minutes from the January meeting.

A treasurer's report was not available.

We received a \$55 check from Reid Johnson booklets/postcards. Hopefully we get more next month. We need to decide in March if we want go back to School Mall. We will see what we get for a payment in February before we make the decision.

We received the \$500 matching funds from Modern Woodmen.

We have been contacted by the post prom committee that they still need to pay for their portion of the insurance, which is \$125. Last years has been paid for.

The yearbook order forms have been sent home. We have 10 orders already. Mrs. White said it is going well and the kids are a big help.

When we work the concession stand for an all day Saturday tournament we get two points instead of one, when working just an evening.

The grants Karla wrote for the gaga pits did not go through. We will apply again and Lindsey Haskell will assist.

The pizza/cookie dough sales have started and all orders/money are due this Friday, February 15th. We discussed prizes for the kids that only bring in donations. Karla will ask if Great Plains would donate some of their prizes. The delivery will be Tuesday, March 12th. Felicia and Amanda have offered to come in and help with the pickup.

The spring book fair will be held May 6-8 in the wrestling room. We will need to look for volunteer workers.

The Redfield Food Center receipts are going well. The last day we can use receipts are from March 31st. The first batch we sent in was for \$195,784. Please keep saving and sending those receipts.

Rob gave us an update on the new playground equipment. Crouch Recreation from Omaha came to the school and brought a diagram of the equipment. Rob has visited with the elementary student council on what they'd like in the equipment. It will be geared more for the first through third graders. It has six swings and a piece that spins. It will be handicap accessible. We will also

be able to keep adding to this main piece of equipment. They are still up in the air on what kind of material will be around the equipment on the ground. We could save a lot of money if we have volunteers help put it together rather than have Crouch Recreation install it. As new drawings come in, Rob will share with the elementary student council. The equipment will be installed by September 2019 and the playground will be open to the public. We do have to have what we want locked in by May 1st, to be installed in August. We need to get the brick purchase shared again so that it's in people's minds. Also it was discussed to show a picture of where the bricks will be put.

Monday, March 11th will be the family night. PTSA will sponsor the meal. Karla will check to see if pizza or chili (plus fixings) will be cheaper. She will also check to see if the lunch room would make cookies instead of asking for donations of bars. We will be looking for volunteers to help serve the meal.

The Dr. Seuss shirts order forms have been sent out. The SDDC is making them again this year. We have several orders already. Dr. Seuss day is Thursday, February 28th at 10:00 a.m. in the PE Building.

We will do the Teachers Breakfast on Tuesday, May 7th. We would like to serve breakfast pizza. Amanda will look into Casey's fundraising.

Karla will place an order for 50 of the nice calendars and will have a royal blue cover with white letters. She will also order the Pre-K through 2nd grade folders and the 3rd-5th grade planners.

We have been invited to the FFA, FCCLA and FBLA luncheon at the armory tomorrow, Wednesday, February 13th from 11:30 a.m. to 1:30 p.m.

We had discussion on the carnival games. We will have a place to store them in the new school, but we don't know how much room we will have yet. The next meeting everyone please come with new carnival game ideas.

We also want to put a drop off of school supplies. Karla will ask the teachers what they want for supplies.
