The Dr. Seuss shirts sales went well, we made approximately \$200. We sold 60 youth and 36 adult shirts.

Karla has received the calendar/planners for next year's gift for the PTSA members. The cost was \$157.76 for 53 planners.

Amanda looked into the Casey's pizza fundraising for the teacher breakfast on Tuesday, May 7th. It didn't look like it could be used for appreciations. She will look into having them purchase a brick.

We discussed having a presentation board of where the bricks will go available during the April 2nd chorus concert. Hopefully this will spark some interest in the purchase of the bricks.

The book fair will be in the wrestling room May 6-8. We will have our evening, open until 8 p.m., on that Tuesday.

We would like to keep officers the same for next year. Will need to be voted on at the next meeting.

Janell will bring a list of seniors to the April meeting to figure out scholarships.

We received a bad check from pizza/cookie dough sales and Karla didn't have a phone number so it will be mailed to the individual.

Karla has spent a lot of time making sure the book fair has the correct address to deliver the book fair books, we do not want them at the library, we need them delivered to the school.

Karla has a gift card from Oriental Trading that expires in April. She will look for carnival supplies like the ticket bags and tickets. Everyone should bring their carnival game ideas to next meeting. In May we will meet at the library to look at the carnival items.
