Scholarships were discussed. It was determined that we will do two scholarships this year. One will be awarded to a boy and one will be awarded to a girl. We discussed what criteria should be for scholarships as attendance continues to diminish.

Fund requests: Mrs. Utecht requested money for kindness rocks. We voted to give her \$145, as requested. FCCLA has four members going to Anaheim, CA. It was decided to give them \$250 for the trip to be split between the four members.
