Shawn gave the treasurer's report. The secretary's report was read by Amy Hermann.

Mrs. Hansen has kids that can bundle the Redfield Food Center receipts. Karla and Amy will get rules written up for adding receipts. We could use one more adder, if you or know of someone interested, please let Karla or a PTSA member know.

We have 16 PTSA membership so far.

We have a delivery date for the cookie dough and pizza sales, February 28th. Breakfast pizza is not an option.

We still need volunteers for the volleyball concession stand on Saturday. If we don't get enough people in the shifts we will not have as much available, such as pretzels. The shift we don't have anyone it will have to be shut down. Anyone that can help please sign up on signup genius.

The book fair books will be delivered to the Carnegie Library the week prior to November 5-8. They will call Amanda when they are about to arrive. Karla will put in a work order to get tables delivered to the library. We will put out a signup genius on October 22nd for set up and workers, the library staff will not be expected to help at all with the book fair. We will set up the book fair on Sunday, November 4th at 6:00 p.m. The book fair hours will be: Monday and Tuesday 10 a.m.-5 p.m., Wednesday 10 a.m.-5 p.m. and Thursday 10 a.m.-4 p.m. We will pack up the book fair on Thursday, November 8th at 4:00 p.m. The teachers will be asked to take the students over to look at the book fair that week. Something will need to be worked out on how to get students back over there once they bring money to purchase. We will make room for the teachers to have "wish lists" for books that parents may purchase for their classrooms.

Karla will be reimbursed for the PBIS dog tags for the younger kids.

Karla had shirt examples from Helen at SDDC and we chose which color vinyl we wanted on each one. They were not able to find the sweatpants without an elastic bottom. Karla will see if hats and socks are a possibility. Amy will make up the clothing order form and the colored one will be posted on facebook and the school webpage. Black and white order forms will be sent home with kids with a note to look online at the colors. We will do a first sale from October 29th to November 2nd and then a second order from November 26th-30th. All orders will be done before Christmas break.

Shane Gross did not have the equipment for the R/D car stickers, Mrs. Brace now has it, but she is not able to do that many colors. Janell visited with a lady who could do them for \$7.50 and we'd sell for \$10 but we'd have to have a minimum order of 200. Amy will check on the ones that were sold previously from a company in Clark. If we do sell the stickers, we could sell them in the concession stand.

We need to start working on the carnival games and getting some new ones, repairing broken ones and going through the money and tickets before next year.

Janell, Michelle and Amy participated in the chili cook-off and will plan to do it next year as well.

Leauna was told we should have the same yearbook rep and not several this year, so it should go more smoothly. Mrs. White would like the junior high students to be involved in the making of yearbook. Leauna will visit with her about this.

We discussed the playground equipment. The school would like it to be handicap accessible. We are still working at raising money for it.
