Shawn gave the treasurer's report. Checking is approximately \$8,900.

Cookie dough and pizza sales will begin on February 4th and end on February 15th. Orders will arrive on March 12th. Please support the children as they sell products to earn money for the new playground.

We will be replacing the School Mall booklets this year with a new program. It runs along the same premise, cards will need to be filled out at home and returned. With each full booklet a student returns, they will be awarded a small toy.

The book fair did well again this year. The fair brought in \$4,056.70. Profits from the book fair will be used to send a book home with each elementary student before Christmas break. It was discussed to get a small token of thanks to each person that worked the fair who doesn't have a child in school.

We discussed recycling school supplies at the end of the year. Often times, youth will bring home their used supplies on the last day of school. An idea is that the children may leave any supplies they do not need at home to be used the following year.

We currently have 24 paid PTSA members. Thank you to those of you that have turned in your memberships.

Apparel order forms will be handed out tomorrow and should be coming home. We will do two separate orders. A color copy can be seen on our Facebook page and a link will also be on the school website. We discussed advertising this in the Redfield Press as often times community members without school children are unable to have access to order apparel. This fundraiser will help to purchase playground equipment. Thank you to Amy for creating the order form.

We received a letter regarding Christmas trees at the courthouse. Amy volunteered to put the tree up again this year. Please stop by the courthouse and check it out.

We discussed the Little Pheasants Facebook page and the benefit it has been to our students. Thank you to those who created the page as well as to everyone who has donated. It truly takes a village.
