

Based on the recommendation of the Governor of South Dakota, the Redfield School District will not be having school March 16-18. The status of school closure beyond that will be assessed throughout the week.

The following action steps have been or will be taken:

- Enhanced cleaning with hospital grade cleaning products
- Increased hand sanitizer availability
- Cancellation of all non-school sponsored activities held in our facilities (for example, men's basketball league)
- Parent-Teacher Conferences will be held via phone, email, or electronic format when possible
- All non-essential activities are cancelled until further notice, including, but not limited to concerts, out of town activities and field trips, competitions, PTA sponsored events, and other similar activities. Field trips within district boundaries may be allowed.

A school message will go out through Infinite Campus on Monday afternoon to find out how we can best teach your child from home. Parents/guardians with Internet access will be directed to the school's website where a survey link will be posted asking about Internet access as well as devices available for their student(s) to use. Staff will be working on developing our online curriculum and getting packets ready for those students who do not have Internet access at home. These packets will be delivered to students without Internet access on Tuesday afternoon and Wednesday morning.

Breakfast and lunch will be available for pick up during this time. So that we prepare the correct amount of food, call the school by 8:00 p.m. the night before to pre-order breakfast and by 10:00 a.m. the day of to pre-order lunch. The standard cost for meals (full price, free, or reduced) will apply. Please access the building through the activities entrances. Breakfast pickup will be from 8:00 a.m. until 9:00 a.m. and lunch pickup will be from 11:30 a.m. until 12:30 p.m. Delivery meals may be an option later in the week. We will keep you informed on the progress of this.

Please remind your students to check their K-12 emails throughout the day for further updates for lessons and materials from teachers.

Please advise your students that the CDC recommends social distancing. Essential travel only is recommended.
