Thank you to students and parents/guardians who are working together with teachers in an effort to make this unique learning experience successful.

Our middle school/high school action team, with guidance from administration, have directed teachers to communicate with students early on that we would limit the amount of weekly work. Teachers were asked to give assignments at the beginning of the week with expectation that students would complete their work by the end of the week. Teachers set office hours for students to connect with their students on Zoom if a student needs assistance.

In addition, many teachers have created "how to" videos to support student understanding in place of their usual in-class instruction.

Because we have minimized the amount of assignments and allowed extra time to get assignments in, each quarter has equal weight in averaging the semester grade.

We ask that you utilize Infinite Campus weekly to make sure your student is finishing assignments. If your student has an "M" from an assignment, this means your student is missing this assignment. The "M" gives your student a zero until the assignment is in. From the beginning of our online learning experience teachers have contacted students via email, zoom meeting and/or phone call when a student is missing assignments. When a student is missing assignments over two weeks, the office is notified and will contact the student and/or parent to remind them.
